



## “Who-is-who” in PROSAFE and EMARS



### Republic of Macedonia

#### Introduction

Republic of Macedonia consists of an area of 25.713 km<sup>2</sup>, with a population of around 2 million. The capital city is Skopje, where the headquarters of the Government and the Assembly of Republic of Macedonia is.

#### Product safety Legislation

In 2006 in Republic of Macedonia a Law on product safety has been passed which provides legal framework for non-food product safety. In the legislation of Republic of Macedonia this law provides a legal foundation for transposing European directives.

- General Product Safety Directive (2001/95/EC) is implemented in the Law on product safety.
- Low Voltage Directive (73/23/EEC) is implemented in the Rulebook for low voltage whose legal foundation is in the Law on product safety.
- Toy Directive (88/378/EEC) is implemented in the Rulebook for the characteristics of the children’s toys circulated whose legal foundation is in the Law on consumer protection.
- Electromagnetic Compatibility (EMC) Directive (89/336/EEC) is implemented in the Rulebook for electromagnetic compatibility whose legal foundation is in the Law on product safety.
- Personal Protective Equipment Directive (89/686/EEC) is implemented in the Rulebook for personal protection equipment whose legal foundation is in the Law on product safety.
- Gas appliances Directive (90/396/EEC) is implemented in the Rulebook Gas appliances which will be published soon in the Official Gazette of Republic of Macedonia.
- Machine Directive (98/37/EC) is implemented in the Rulebook for machines safety whose legal foundation is in the Law on product safety.
